Worthing Downlanders are a voluntary organisation dedicated to supporting and defending the ownership and control of all Worthing Council's existing Downland estate, and supporting the management of this Downland estate for public purposes, free of built development.

These public purposes include: the maximum statutory open public access to this land, the enhancement of the wildlife resources of this land, especially with a view to restoration of the damaged down pasture mantle, and supporting sustainable farming initiatives. Worthing Downlanders will also be supporting all campaigns to save Green Belt land from development.

We hold regular events, field trips and educational activities for members - including popular historical walks and talks with local historian: Chris Hare.

We are part of the Worthing Borough Council Working Party which was set up to manage the farm tenancy of Downland adjacent to Cissbury Ring - namely Tenants Hill & Mount Carvey. The Working Party also includes representatives from the National Trust, South Downs National Park and Natural England.
